# FEE SCHEDULE

**BURGLAR AND HOLD-UP/PANIC ALARMS MUST HAVE SEPARATE PERMITS.** Contact your alarm company if you are not sure which permits your alarm system requires.

## RESIDENTIAL ALARM PERMIT

Burglar: \$30.00 each. (Annual renewal required, fee \$30.00)

Combination burglar and hold-up/panic: \$50.00. (Annual renewal required, fee \$50.00)

## NON-RESIDENTIAL/BUSINESS ALARM PERMIT

Burglar: \$70.00 each. (Annual renewal required, fee \$70.00)

Hold-up/panic: \$70.00. (Annual renewal required, fee \$70.00)

Combination burglar and hold-up/panic: \$140.00. (Annual renewal required, fee \$140.00)

**GOVERNMENT OFFICES:** Alarm system is on premises occupied by the United States Government, the State of Texas, the County of Harris, or the City of Houston situated within the corporate limits of the City, a permit is mandatory, but no fee is required.

**ALARM RESPONSE RESIDENTIAL:** Three (3) false burglar alarm calls are allowed without a charge with a burglar alarm permit per year. The 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> false alarm call is chargeable at \$50.00 each and the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> call is chargeable at \$75.00 each. Thereafter each false alarm call is chargeable at \$100.00 each. Permits are subject to revocation after the 7<sup>th</sup> false call and no response. **Burglar alarm systems without a permit are chargeable at \$100.00 per response and/or no response.**

Hold-up/panic alarm systems are allowed one (1) false call without charge with a hold-up/panic permit. Thereafter the 2<sup>nd</sup> call is chargeable at \$100.00, the 3<sup>rd</sup> false call at \$200.00 and the 4<sup>th</sup> false call is chargeable at \$300.00. Thereafter the 5<sup>th</sup> false alarm and above are chargeable at \$400.00 (each). **Panic alarm systems without a permit are chargeable at \$220.00 per response.**

**ALARM RESPONSE NON-RESIDENTIAL/BUSINESS:** Three (3) false alarm calls are allowed without a charge with a burglar alarm permit per year. The 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> false alarm call is chargeable at \$50.00 each and the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> false call is chargeable at \$75.00 each. Thereafter each false call is chargeable at \$100.00 each. Permits are subject to revocation after the 7<sup>th</sup> false call and no response. **Non-residential burglar alarm system without a permit are chargeable at \$200.00 per response and /or no response.**

Hold-up/panic alarm systems are allowed one (1) false call without charge with a hold-up/panic permit. Thereafter the 2<sup>nd</sup> false alarm call is chargeable at \$200.00, and the 3<sup>rd</sup> false call at \$400.00. The 4<sup>th</sup> false alarm and above are chargeable at \$500.00 each. **Non-residential panic alarm systems without a permit are chargeable at \$350.00 per response.**
